America Enters WWI

RECAP:

JUNE 28TH, 1914 - Archduke Franz Ferdinand and his wife are shot by Serbian nationalists ★ Austria-Hungary is angry at Serbia, sends list of demands, gives ultimatums JULY 28TH, 1914 - Austria-Hungary declares war on Serbia, WWI begins!

The 2 Sides of WWI:

Central Powers:

- GERMANY
- AUSTRIA-HUNGARY
- OTTOMAN EMPIRE
- BULGARIA

- RUSSIA

- FRANCE

Allied Powers:

- GREAT BRITAIN

- ITAL Y

American Enters War:

While the United States generally supported the **ALLIED POWERS**, they officially remained **NEUTRAL** at the beginning of the war.

- Neutrality: NOT SUPPORTING OR HELPING EITHER SIDE OF A WAR, CONFLICT, OR DISAGREEMENT

Germany Interferes:

Although the U.S. was officially neutral, Germany continued to attack ships carrying **AMERICAN PASSENGERS**

These attacks were part of a German policy called **UNRESTRICTED WARFARE**

ANY SHIP TRAVELING IN WATERS AROUND GREAT BRITAIN WAS SUBJECT TO **ATTACK BY GERMAN U-BOATS**

Sinking of the Lusitania:

The Lusitania was **<u>TORPEDOED</u>** by German U-Boats. Fearing US entry into war, Germany agreed to stop ATTACKING PASSENGER SHIPS

The Zimmerman Note:

<u>REPEATED ATTACKS ON SHIPPING</u> brought the U.S. close to war with Germany. The discovery of the **ZIMMERMAN NOTE** February of 1917 was the final push. The Note:

- The Zimmerman Note was **SECRET MESSAGE FROM A GERMAN DIPLOMAT TO** MEXICO
- The note proposed that MEXICO SHOULD ATTACK THE US IN EXCHANGE FOR US LAND

The US enters WWI on the ALLIED POWERS SIDE in April of 1917.
