

Q3 Book Project-- Book Report and Scrapbook Page!

Project due: Tuesday, 3/24

1. Select and read a biography.

- This needs to be a book in the form of a biography, memoir, autobiography, etc.
- Please submit your selection of a person and book by February 13th.
- Think of someone who inspires you to try your best! This could be a famous politician, president, activist, historical figure, philanthropist, or anyone else who has made significant contributions to society. This person can be living or dead.

2. Write a Book Report: (Times New Roman, double-spaced, 12 point font)

Address the following in your paper:

Basic facts of life:

- Birthday
- Birthplace
- Current age (if alive) OR age at the time of death
- Family details
- Their life (childhood, young adult, adult)
- Their likes/dislikes
- Places they have lived

Education:

- Did this person go to school? If so, where? If not, why not?
- What did they study? Why?
- Did they belong to any organizations?

Accomplishments:

- What are they most known for?
- What contributions have they made to society?
- What is a quote/action from this person that most sticks with you? Why?

Motivations:

- What motivated them to achieve their accomplishments?
- What major events in their life impacted their future actions? How would these events have changed your life? Would you have had the same reaction?

Lessons:

- How has your thinking changed as a result of reading the biography?
- Why did you choose this biography? What about this person's life surprised you?

What if?:

- What do you think would be different today if the person had not lived?

Perspectives:

- How does their life story help you to understand a different viewpoint?

Story Left Unwritten:

- What questions would you ask this person if you could have a conversation with him/her?

3. Create a scrapbook page:

On a scrapbook piece of paper, include the following:

- Date of birth (and death if this applies)
- Greatest accomplishment(s) and reasoning
- 3 interesting facts about this person
- At least one 'real' picture of this person
- 3 pictures that symbolize/represent your person

4. Create a Works Cited Page: (Attach to your book report paper)

Include sources for the following:

- Your book
- Any pictures you use on your scrapbook page
