Alliance	Agreements between nations to aid and protect one another		
Armistice	An agreement to stop fighting		
Dictator	A ruler who has complete power over a country		
Imperialism	The effort of a nation to build and empire of colonies.		
League of Nations	The international organization created after WWI to promote world peace and cooperation.		
Militarism	A policy of glorifying military power and keeping a standing army always prepared for war		
Nationalism	A sense of strong pride in one's own nation or ethnic group.

Neutrality	A policy of supporting neither side in a war		
Propaganda	Ideas spread to influence public opinion either for or against a cause		
Reparations	Payment made for war damages		
Stalemate	A situation with no chance for progress		
Totalitarianism	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc.)		
Treaty of Versailles	An agreement created by the Allied Powers that blamed Germany for WWI and made them pay for war damages, reduce their military, and give up territories gained by the war.		
Trench Warfare	A form of warfare in which opposing armies fight each other from trenches dug in the battlefield.
